FROM THE SCORER

New Electronic Scoring System

I'm pleased to report that the new scoring system has been very positively embraced by virtually all members who are now using the system confidently and allayed of the concerns originally worrying some members.

We have produced an instruction sheet attached to the notice board directly behind the log in master tablet for those who wish to assist in setting up the system on match days. I'll go through the sheet with any interested members each match day until we have enough experienced parties to set up and run a match without the Scorer having to be in attendance.

The instant printing of scores at the end of the day has been very popular however some members have requested a larger font be used to produce the results. Unfortunately this facility is not currently available. One suggested solution is to take a picture with a smart phone and expand the picture for closer evaluation.

We have also been asked if the synchronising of competitors entered into the master tablet in the clubroom with the tablets on the stages could be automated. At this stage this is not possible however the Club Captain has been in touch with Practiscore to ask if it could be possible in a future release, but as yet has not received a reply. We'll keep you posted on any advance in this area.

Several issues have come up during the past few weeks but we have been able to address them, usually quickly (we are still learning on the go). Something that has not been addressed is the addition of competitors on the tablets out on the ranges. PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE do not do this. If a competitor has logged in on the master table and for some reason synchronising the stage tablet to the master tablet doesn't work, DO NOT add the competitor on the range. CALL THE SCORER to assist! The addition of a competitor on the range will cause problems when we do our final synchronising to produce final results as their names will be entered twice. Headaches for the Scorer will ensue.....and of course we don't want that.

Thanks again everyone for your cooperation.
